  - 2. Judgment Entry
- -Bring all of this information, along with your payment, to the Clerk's office for processing.
- -When we receive your application and payment, where necessary, we will process your application, and you will receive a notice in the mail with a hearing date.
- -THERE WILL BE A MANDATORY HEARING DATE AND YOUR ABSENCE COULD RESULT IN YOUR REQUEST BEING DENIED
