 - 1. Application for Sealing or Expungement. This form must be filled out by you. The clerks in the office are not allowed to help you in completing the application.
 - 2. Judgment Entry
- Bring all of this information, along with your payment, to the Clerk's office for processing.
- When we receive your application and payment, where necessary, we will process your application, and you will receive a notice in the mail with a hearing date.
- THERE WILL BE A MANDATORY HEARING DATE AND YOUR ABSENCE COULD RESULT IN YOUR REQUEST BEING DENIED
